

Dr. Wallace is a professor of Biochemistry and Molecular Biology at the University of Minnesota Medical School. His research has focused on mitochondrial toxicity, particularly the effects of foreign chemicals on the function and the genomic regulation of mitochondrial metabolic homeostasis of the cell. Dr. Wallace is past president of the Society of Toxicology, the Mitochondrial Research Society, the American Board of Toxicology and the Academy of Toxicological Sciences. He has also served on the Board of Directors for the United Mitochondrial Disease Foundation and the Environmental Health Sciences Institute and he recently resigned after 20 years as Editor-in-Chief of Toxicology.
